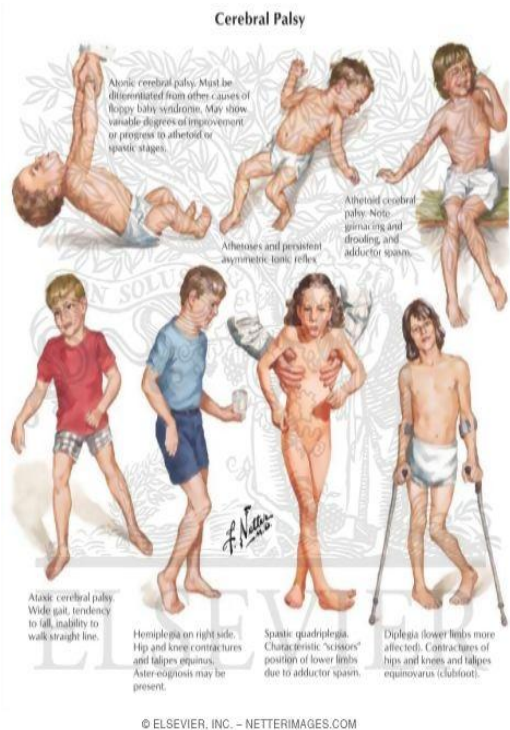


SYMPTOMS

This results in affecting a person's ability to move certain parts of the body depending on severity.

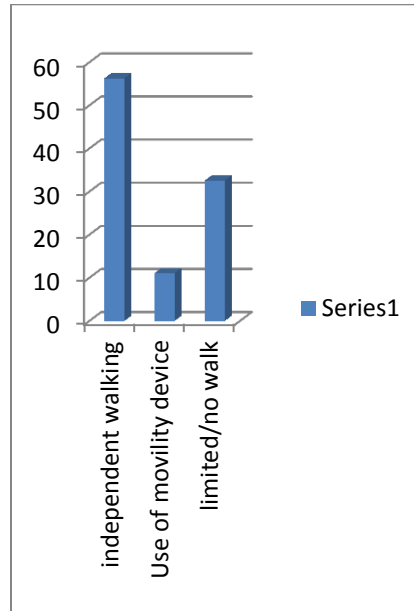
Diagnosis
